7.3 - Institutional Distinctiveness <u>2019-20</u>

The uniqueness of the College lies in its vision to create an environment where education is accessible, affordable, and inclusive. Taking inspiration from the founder who gave away all his riches for the upliftment of the local community by creating a trust with the aim of providing education for the comprehensive development of the young minds, the College focuses on reaching out to the girl students whose parents have limited financial resources or are otherwise hesitant to send their daughters to Colleges for higher education. The College visualizes itself as a platform for holistic excellence which aims at empowering young women through skill oriented programs relevant to regional and global dynamic employment market. Our mission is to provide quality higher education to create citizens equipped with knowledge, skills, and values to build an inclusive, just, and progressive society. The vision, mission, and goals all have been aligned and focussed on the academic area. All other activities remain in the surroundings to complement this area to create a holistic impact on the development of the students. The close-knit family atmosphere, where every member of the teaching faculty, office, and support staff is equally concerned about the well-being of the students, promotes the sense of safety and trust amongst the parents. The administrative authorities are easily approachable and maintain close rapport with the students and parents. College inspires for a truthful living for the enlightenment of the self. For this, we strive to create awareness regarding basic human values through exemplary behavior. The smooth communication between the students, teachers, parents and Principal, helps in planning the academic programs in such a way that serves best the educational and social responsibilities of the College. The academic calendar gives equal emphasis to promote the emotional and mental well-being of the students. The issues which generally cause stress and anxiety at a young age and the moral and ethical dilemmas with which youth usually grapple are taken up through discussion and in the form of counseling. Freeships to single parent-child or to economically disadvantaged students, facility to deposit fee in easy installments, free books, special classes for the weak students, free access to online resources, tele-counselling, Earn While You Learn scheme are a few initiatives that are undertaken regularly to facilitate the students. The result of all the efforts put in by the Team SSSS is clearly visible in the form of well-rounded personalities of the graduate who are ready to take upon bigger challenges of life.

7.3 - Institutional Distinctiveness <u>2020-21</u>

1) **Inclusiviness**: The college follows an open merit based admission policy offering equal opportunities to all irrespective of caste, community, class etc.which is evident from the fact that approximately 50 % of the student's enrolment is from minorities/SC/ OBC categories. Further, a number of students (from under privileged section of the society or migrant labour families or the families who were hit hard by the COVID crisis economically) who were unable to pay college fees were facilitated, granted liberal fee concession under Baba Nank 550th Parkash Purab Scholarship Scheme (BNPS), allowed to pay fees in easy monthly installment.

2) **Connectivity**: Throughout the period of lockdown in the absence of in person classes a close contact was maintained with the students by the college through virtual mediums. Daily motivational message was sent through class Whatsapp Groups. Besides regular classes as per the official timetable, special extra classes were held in the evening through online mode for the students who were slow in learning or find difficulty due to net connectivity. Recorded audio lecture, PPTs, E-Books were provided to ensure better understanding of the difficult topics.

A number of events were held through virtual mode to keep the students engaged and also help them utilize their creativity during the stressful pandemic times. The prime motive behind all such endeavours was to extend moral support to each student so that no one feels isolated or strained. The message intended had been that we as family stand together in times of crisis. Tele counseling service was enabled for counseling students seven days in a week and various psychological issues of students were resolved successfully.

7.3 - Institutional Distinctiveness <u>2021-22</u>

The focus of the College is primarily on building self-awareness amongst its students. It has been realized by social scientists all over the world that mental health is an issue of prime concern in 21st century, and especially in post-pandemic situations. Hence, we intend to create an environment where young girls are made conscious of their inner being and that by being emotionally intelligent, they can transform the personal and professional challenges in a stress free manner and are empowered to command change and spark innovation. The institution has been successful in building a culture of mutual respect and love where students feel free to seek guidance regarding their personal or career related issues. Students are oriented towards seeking higher goals of living, to think deeply and understand the true purpose of education through reflection and by engaging in questioning, debate, discussions, role plays, class room sessions, and theatre. Guest lectures, workshops, personal-contact-programmes (PCP) and counseling sessions are held regularly to widen their horizon. Special projects are also undertaken whereby students and faculty learn how to relate and respect the self, other fellow-beings, the social environment, and the natural environment and thus, promote the values of compassion and empathy.
