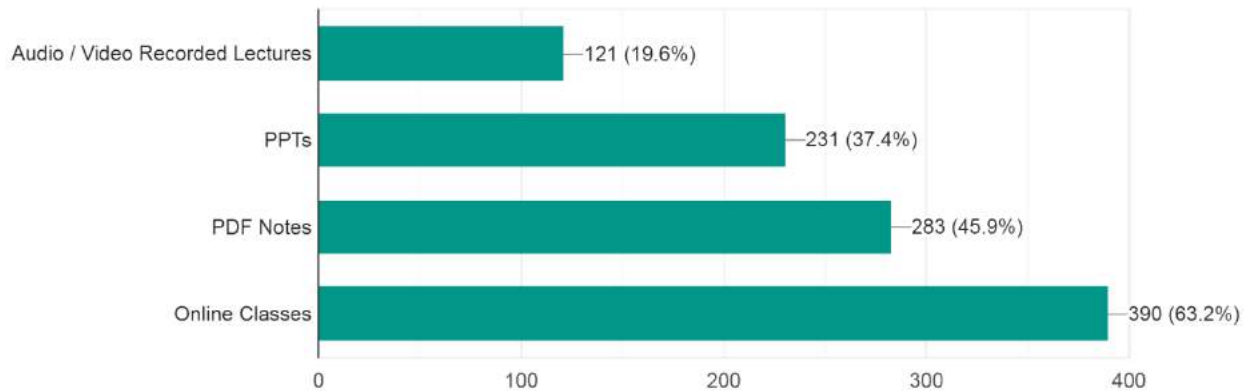

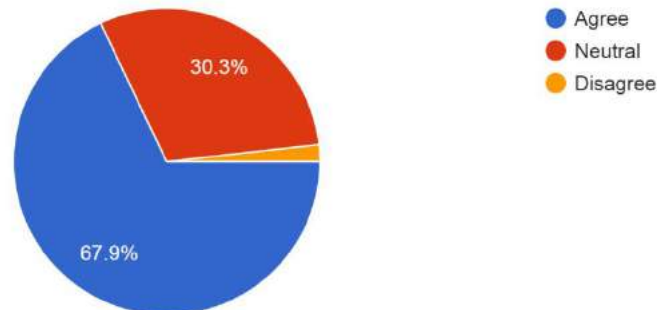
1. Beside online teaching through Google App, which of the resources the teachers using for teaching?

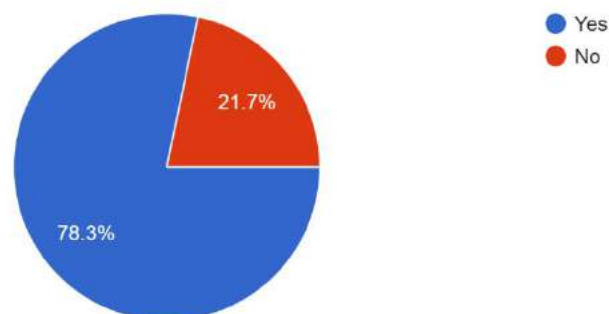
2. The lectures were structured:

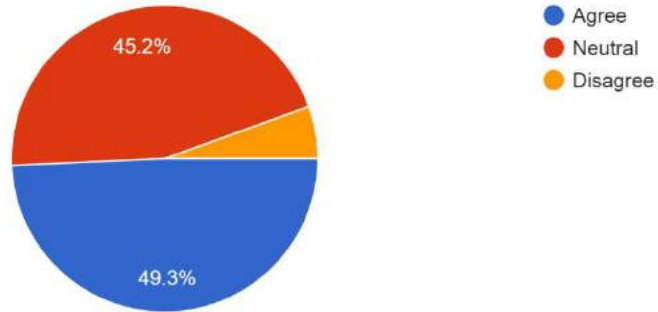
3. Do you find these classes effective in covering the syllabus?

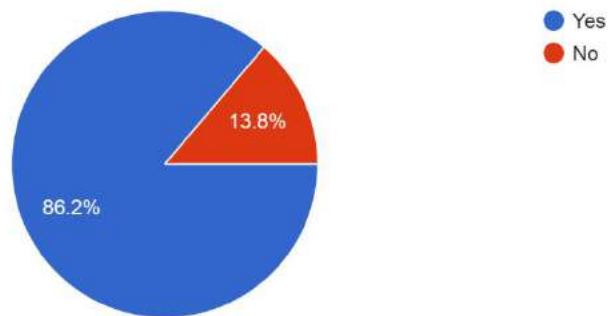
4. The content presented was clear and understandable:

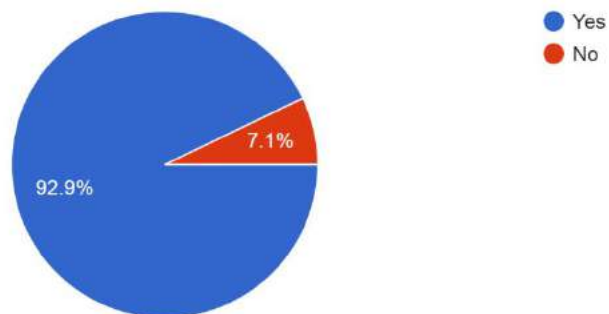
5. Was there ample opportunity for asking questions?

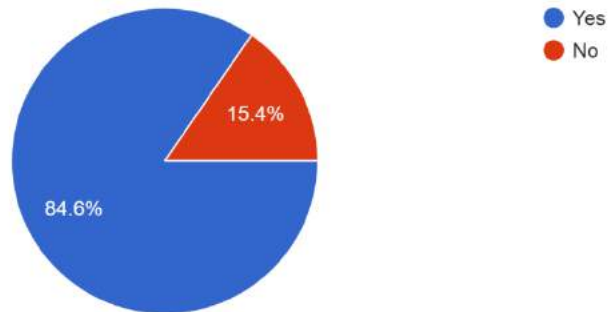
6. Were your queries answered?

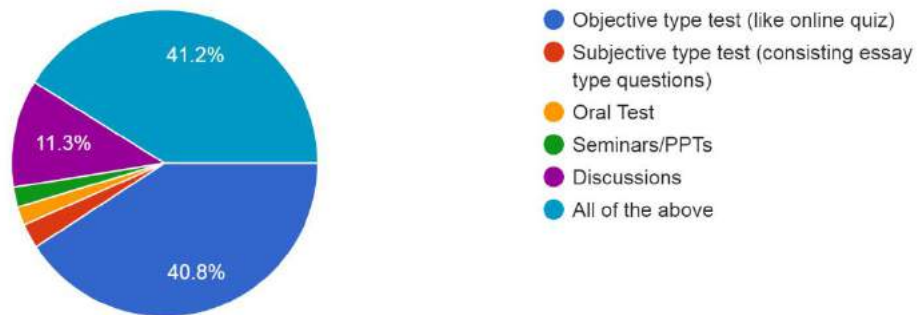
7. In your opinion , are the teachers successful in making online classes interesting and informative?

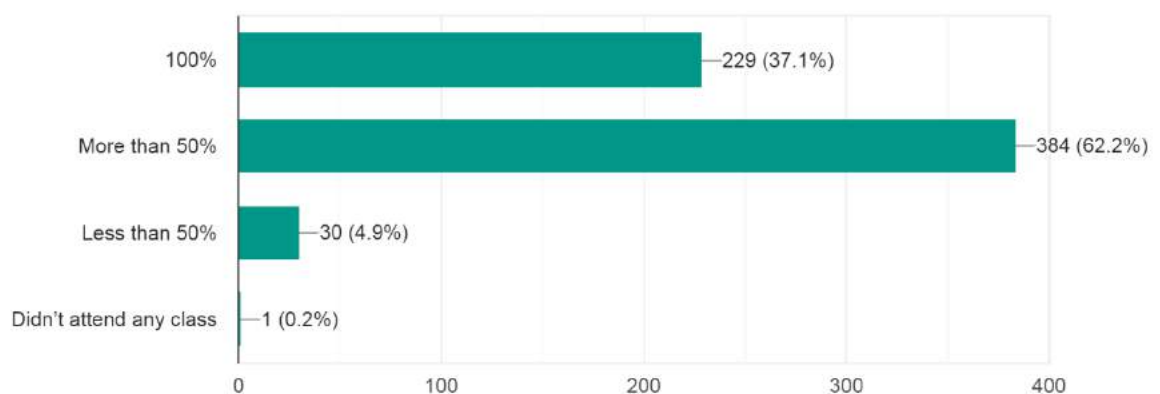
8. Which modes have been used by the teachers for assessing your understanding of the subject?

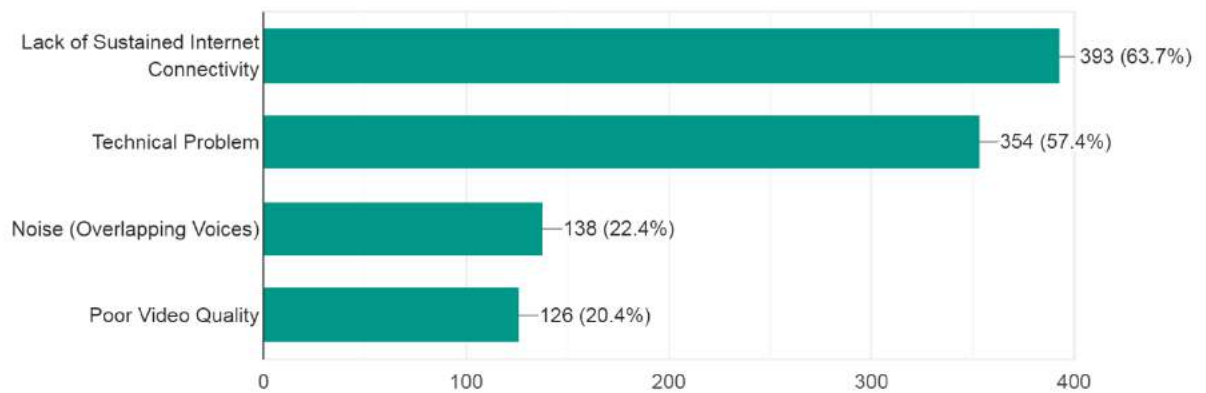
10. Your attendance during the online class was:

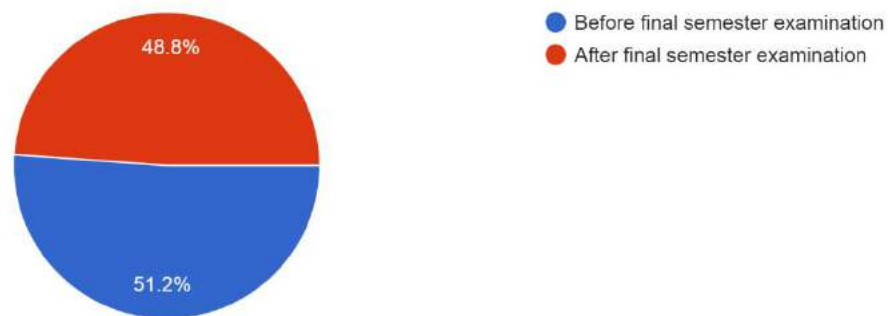
11. Which of the following challenges are faced by you during Online Lectures?
